Virginia Green is the statewide program that works to reduce the environmental impact of Virginia's tourism industry. The program awards Virginia Green Certification to tourism-related businesses taking voluntary actions to reduce harmful impacts on the environment.

In 1998, James River Bus Lines' headquarters was designed in order to conserve energy with energy efficient lighting; geothermal heating and cooling; natural lighting; and reduced water usage. Our maintenance departments recycle used fluids (oil, antifreeze, refrigerant); we drain and recycle our used oil filters; our wash water is filtered and tested before entering the sewer.
